SHARE HOPE



PURSUE GOD

DIGITAL ENGAGEMENT ((-))

Digital technology is a critical tool in helping people take next steps. By engaging people in digital platforms, we are able to connect with them where they live, work, and play. Platforms like YouTube, Instagram, Facebook, and X (formerly called Twitter) not only allow us to extend the weekend experience throughout the week, but connect people to each other. We have a 47% average audience of 25-34 year olds.

SHARE HOPE TITHES & OFFERINGS

Tithing is an act of worship, recognizing that God is our source for all provision and blessing. We use the tithes and offerings we receive to make an **impact** on our community and the world.

Total amount given by Impact-ers in 2023: **\$1,399,272** (YTD)
Total amount given by Impact-ers online in 2023: **\$797,436** (YTD)
Estimated number of donors that gave in 2023: **418 donors** (YTD)

57% of the 2023 giving came from online sources.

In order for Impact to meet its expenses and needs the tithes and offerings must average \$33,232/week. In 2023 the offering averaged \$29,152/week, leaving a shortfall of \$4,080/week.

GO AND BE

As a church, we want to be known for our extraordinary generosity. This year we saw generosity expressed as we partnered with our local and global missions.

O Lifeline

Special missional support highlights:

- We had four of our supported missions visit Impact: Choices Pregnancy Center in April; Passion Ministries in July; Lifeline Christian Mission in August; and Light of Life in November.
- In 2023, the Missions Team added two new missions that Impact supports on a monthly basis: Mustard Seed Network (Tanner & Delaney Salva) based in Japan and Hippo Valley Christian Missions (Russell Johnson) based in Africa.
- There was a total of \$2,900 sent out for special givings in 2023.
- In September, we held our Mass Mobilization project. This was a food packing event. We packed 52,548 meals of rice & vegetables. We saw great community which led to new Growth Groups being formed and new people attending Impact!
 There was also great participation from Impact Students.
- We have contributed \$2,879.59 to our Good Samaratin fund to help families in need.
- In November, we packed 777 boxes for Operation Christmas Child.

The Landing Community Center is a significant part of our local Go & Be efforts. This is provided through the generous contributions of Impact-ers. The Landing is Pittsburgh's largest free indoor park and has been rated as one of Pittsburgh's best play areas for kids.






MEGA Fall Fest hosted over 1,100 guests in 2023!
