I. The Landing Policies and Procedures

1. Code of Conduct

The Landing is a family-friendly organization. We expect all our guests to model the four values of **caring, honesty, respect,** and **responsibility** in their conduct and language. Guests are encouraged to take responsibility for their personal well-being and safety by asking any person whose behavior threatens their comfort to refrain from such behavior. Anyone who feels uncomfortable should report the behavior to a staff person or volunteer host. Notify a staff member or volunteer host if assistance is needed.

The following actions and behaviors are not permitted and will not be tolerated:

- Using or possessing illegal substances, drugs, alcohol, smoke products, tobacco products, or vapes.
- Harassment or intimidation by words, gestures, body language, or any type of menacing behavior.
- Physical contact with another person in an angry, aggressive, or threatening way.
- Verbally abusive behavior including angry/vulgar language, swearing, name calling, or shouting.
- Sexually explicit conversation or behavior.
- Theft or behavior that results in the destruction or loss of property.

2. Bouncy Blvd

(FOR GUESTS 42" AND UNDER)

Please help us keep it safe and clean:

- Keep hands and feet to yourself.
- Remove shoes (this applies to all adults and children).
- Stay off all walls.
- Keep all food and drinks outside of Bouncy Boulevard.
- Keep foam pieces inside Bouncy Blvd.

3. General House Rules

- We are a drug, alcohol, smoke & tobacco free (including vaping) facility.
- Stay off all ways.
- Sports such as baseball, lacrosse and hockey should be kept outdoors.
- Keep all ball play respectful of facility and guests, and only in the turf and gym areas.
- Stand on scooters are the only wheeled items permitted.
- Nerf Guns are allowed in the Gymnasium (Sport Court) during private rental times only.
- Certified service animals are permitted.
- Share all spaces if not privately rented.

The Landing reserves the right to ask any guest to leave the premises for any reason.

4. Emergency Procedures

ACCIDENTS

• Should an accident, injury, or incident occur while you are at The Landing, contact a staff member or volunteer host.

FIRE

• If the fire alarm sounds or The Landing must be evacuated, all activities must stop and all individuals must exit the facility immediately.

• Next to The Happenings rack in the turf area and underneath the flatscreen TV in the middle of the lobby.
